Dog Import Checklist & Quick Guide | TailHarbor | Updated April 2026

KEY INFORMATION

STANDARD ROUTE: No titer test required

Preparation Time:	4-8 weeks
Microchip:	ISO 11784/11785 (must be implanted BEFORE rabies vaccination)
Rabies Vaccination:	Required. Minimum 21 days before travel (primary). Keep boosters current.
Titer Test:	Not required (EU-listed/equivalent origin)
Documentation:	Animal Health Certificate (AHC) issued max 10 days before arrival. Single-use.
Breed Restrictions:	PPP (Potentially Dangerous Dogs): Pit Bull Terrier, Rottweiler, Dogo Argentino, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, American Sta...
Cropping/Docking:	Dogs with cropped ears or docked tails may face import restrictions in Spain
Insurance:	Mandatory liability insurance required for ALL dogs in Spain
Registration:	Censo Municipal registration within 30 days of arrival

USEFUL TIPS

- Start the process as early as possible. Delays with lab results or vet appointments can push back your timeline significantly.
- Research airline pet policies early. Some airlines have limited cargo spots, especially in summer. Temperature embargoes apply above 30C / below -5C at any transit airport.
- Start crate training weeks before travel. A calm, crate-confident dog will have a much less stressful journey.
- If your dog is a restricted or mixed breed, get a breed DNA test and official documentation before traveling. Border officials in Spain can refuse entry for banned breeds.
- Make 2 copies of every document (microchip cert, vaccination record, AHC, airline confirmation). Keep originals in your carry-on and copies in checked luggage.

PRE-TRAVEL CHECKLIST

EARLY PREPARATION

- Confirm your dog's breed is permitted in Spain
- Research airline pet policies and book cargo/cabin spot
- Purchase IATA-approved travel crate (correct size for your dog)
- Begin crate training

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Microchip implanted (ISO 11784/11785) -- BEFORE vaccination
- Rabies vaccination administered (min. 21 days before travel)

DOCUMENTATION

- Animal Health Certificate obtained (max 10 days before arrival)
- All vaccination records compiled
- Copies of all documents made (2 sets)
- Airline booking confirmation printed

TRAVEL DAY

- All original documents in carry-on bag
- Crate labeled with your name, phone, destination, and 'Live Animal'
- Water dish filled and attached inside crate
- Arrive at airport early (3+ hours for international with pet)

AFTER ARRIVAL IN SPAIN

- Present documents at Travellers' Point of Entry / Border Control
- Register dog in Censo Municipal within 30 days
- Register with local veterinarian
- Obtain mandatory pet liability insurance
