Dog Import Checklist & Quick Guide | TailHarbor | Updated April 2026

## KEY INFORMATION

STANDARD ROUTE: No titer test required

|                            |   |
|----------------------------|---|
| <b>Preparation Time:</b>   | 3-6 weeks   |
| <b>Microchip:</b>          | ISO 11784/11785 (must be implanted BEFORE rabies vaccination)                       |
| <b>Rabies Vaccination:</b> | Required. Minimum 21 days before travel (primary). Keep boosters current.           |
| <b>Titer Test:</b>         | Not required (EU-listed/equivalent origin)  |
| <b>Documentation:</b>      | Animal Health Certificate (AHC) issued max 10 days before arrival. Single-use.      |
| <b>Cropping/Docking:</b>   | Dogs with cropped ears or docked tails may face import restrictions in Belgium      |
| <b>Registration:</b>       | DogID registration within 8 days of arrival   |
| <b>Entry Points (BIP):</b> | Brussels National Airport (24/7), Liège Airport, Brussels South Charleroi, Oostende |
| <b>Import Authority:</b>   | FASFC/AFSCA (Federal Agency for Safety of the Food Chain)                           |

## USEFUL TIPS

- Start the process as early as possible. Delays with lab results or vet appointments can push back your timeline significantly.
- Research airline pet policies early. Some airlines have limited cargo spots, especially in summer. Temperature embargoes apply above 30C / below -5C at any transit airport.
- Start crate training weeks before travel. A calm, crate-confident dog will have a much less stressful journey.
- Non-EU arrivals into Belgium must enter through an approved Border Inspection Post (BIP): Brussels National Airport (24/7), Liège Airport, Brussels South Charleroi, Oostende.
- Make 2 copies of every document (microchip cert, vaccination record, AHC, airline confirmation). Keep originals in your carry-on and copies in checked luggage.

## PRE-TRAVEL CHECKLIST

### EARLY PREPARATION

- Confirm your dog's breed is permitted in Belgium
- Research airline pet policies and book cargo/cabin spot
- Purchase IATA-approved travel crate (correct size for your dog)
- Begin crate training

### MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Microchip implanted (ISO 11784/11785) -- BEFORE vaccination
- Rabies vaccination administered (min. 21 days before travel)

### DOCUMENTATION

- Animal Health Certificate obtained (max 10 days before arrival)
- All vaccination records compiled
- Copies of all documents made (2 sets)
- Airline booking confirmation printed

### TRAVEL DAY

- All original documents in carry-on bag
- Crate labeled with your name, phone, destination, and 'Live Animal'
- Water dish filled and attached inside crate
- Arrive at airport early (3+ hours for international with pet)

### AFTER ARRIVAL IN BELGIUM

- Present documents at Travellers' Point of Entry / Border Control
- Register dog in DogID within 8 days
- Register with local veterinarian
- Obtain pet liability insurance (recommended)
